Dear Community Friend:

Once a year, the Stage Door Conservatory holds a special benefit drawing to raise funds for its wonderful summer programs in theater for children in our community. I am writing to you today to ask if your business could help us with this effort by donating of a prize for our raffle, especially an item that might appeal to families and their children.

Proceeds from our raffle will be used to support our Scholarship Fund! Through this Fund, we can offer opportunities to low-income children to attend our camp, even if their family cannot afford to send them. Since we are a small nonprofit, and rely upon tuition fees to pay for the costs of operating our camp, the amount we can contribute to the Fund ourselves is limited. We are appealing to members of our local community, especially those with a known interest in the lives and welfare of children, to ask if they could help.

This year, we have received many more requests for aid from families with very marginal incomes – single parents and working families with children who love to sing and act, but who cannot afford the cost of a program like ours, even though we charge much less per child than many other camps. Could you help us, so we can extend a special opportunity to them to join us?

By supporting our raffle, you will help us extend the opportunity to more children to attend our special summer programs. You will also be showing our community just how we can accomplish together in meeting important community needs.

Our raffle will be held on August 15 at the Piedmont Theater following our final performance of BYE BYE BIRDIE (which will be performed by the 5th through 9th graders participating in our On Broadway program this summer!) Each donor to our raffle will be gratefully acknowledged:

Stage Door Conservatory was founded more than a decade ago and is a charitable nonprofit organization. We offer four enriching summer programs in musical theater including Kids on Stage, On Broadway, Teens On Stage and Backstage. This year Teens on Stage will produce and present CHICAGO and On Broadway will produce and present BYE BYE BIRDIE for three days each before live public audiences at the PIEDMONT THEATER in Piedmont and the JULIA MORGAN CENTER in Berkeley.

In addition to instruction in acting, singing, dancing and stage design and theater arts, every child becomes part of a supportive extended community, not only rehearsing and performing in a play, but becoming integrally involved in all aspects of our production. Through Backstage, our popular apprentice program, we provide opportunities to older children to assist with the theatrical and artistic aspects of our productions.

The arts provide such a rich opportunity for growth and learning for children, helping them develop not only as artists, but as persons – which is why it's been so exciting to include so many young members of our community in our programs each summer. In addition to providing a memorable summer experience, exemplary training in theater arts and rewarding opportunities to perform, we are committed to helping each child find and express that unique spark that is theirs alone.
